The Promise Award

The Promise Award has been given by King's Ransom Labradors and Armbrook Labradors in honor of Can. CH Ransom's Perpetual Promise CDX, MH. This award is given for the balanced Labrador Retriever that meets the following criteria:

- 1. Titles do not have to be earned in one calendar year. However, to apply for this award, the dog must have at least one each of the following:
 - a. One AKC hunting title.
 - b. Two AKC conformation points.
 - c. One other AKC title, i.e., agility, obedience, or tracking.
- 2. A dog cannot qualify two years in a row with all the same titles.
- 3. Applicants' titles or points will be ranked as follows:
 - a. <u>Hunting titles</u>:
 - AFC, FC, or qualify at Master National, 5 points MH, 4 points
 - SH, 3 points
 - JH, 2 points
 - b. <u>Conformation</u>:
 - CH, 5 points Two or more majors, 4 points One major, 3 points Two points, 2 points
 - c. <u>Performance events</u>: All three performance events are equal. Only one performance title will be used in calculating points for a particular year.

Obedience: OTCH, 5 points UDX, 4 points UD, 3 points CDX, 2 points CD, 1 point Agility: MACH, 5 points MX or MXJ, 4 points AX or AXJ, 3 points OA or OAJ, 2 points NA or NAJ, 1 point Tracking: CT, 5 points VST, 3 points TDX, 2 points TD, 1 point

4. Should two or more applicants be rated equally, the trophy will be shared.
